Meeting Minutes Village of Holmen Finance and Personnel Committee March 7, 2017

The meeting of the Holmen Finance and Personnel Committee was held Tuesday, March 7, 2017, in the Village Board Room.

Hornberg stated that the 2016 audit would begin March 27th and that 2016 proves to be a very successful year financially.
