HOLMEN MEN'S TUESDAY SOFTBALL LEAGUE - 12" SLOW PITCH – TEAM REGISTRATION

2010 season begins April 27 and ends August 17. There is space for 20 teams (2 Divisions: A & B) to play on Tuesday evenings at Deer Wood Park. League uses ASA bat rules and playing rules, with some local modifications. **Hit your own ball. Teams provide all game balls** (ASA approved, 12" optic yellow, .44 COR, 375lb. compression). Teams will get an ASA membership with entry fee. Games are played at 6pm, 7pm, 8pm, and 9pm on three fields.

Rules & League Meeting: Tuesday, March 2, 2010 at 6:00pm, Holmen Village Hall.

- *If you want any say on this year's rules, please attend or send a capable alternate.*
- **MAJOR TOPIC: 2010 ASA has changed limited arc from 12' maximum to 10' maximum. SHOULD WE ADOPT THIS CHANGE?**
- *Other Topics: Bats, balls, playing rules, league procedures, comments, concerns, etc.*

Entry Fee Deadline: Wednesday, March 24, 2010 (for last year's teams)

New Team Lottery: Friday, March 26, 2010 (entry fee must be paid to be eligible)

Fee: \$250 team entry fee, with non-residents paying \$20 per person additional.
*Non-Resident fees per team capped at eleven paid players per team (\$220 max. per team).
The 12th+ non-resident player's on your roster would not have a non-resident fee.*

Players must provide official proof that they are a Holmen Resident or pay the non-resident fee if they cannot provide proof. Examples of proof: include a photocopy of driver's license, water bill, or some official current document that states the player's name and address. Players can now play non-resident fees online.

Managers:

- *Require your players to bring you some type of proof of Holmen residency to a pre-season meeting or practices so all players proof of residency (Holmen) or non-resident fees can be attached to your roster and turned-in to the Holmen Village Hall prior to the first game of the season. **Rosters without proof attached will not be accepted.***
- *All teams will be registered with Wisconsin ASA. You will also receive an ASA rulebook, scorebook, quarterly newsletters, and additional information.*
- *Tournaments:*
 - **KornFest Men's and Women's Tournaments will be August 20-22, 2010, \$125 entry fee.**
