Village of Holmen Law Enforcement Committee April 5, 2016

The meeting of the Holmen Law Enforcement Committee was held Tuesday April 5, 2016, in the conference room of the Village Hall.

Chair Steve Johnston called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Committee members Steve Johnston, Chuck Olson, and Bill Ebner. Also in attendance was Shane Collins.

Approval of Minutes Bill Ebner and Chuck Olson motioned to approve the minutes of the March 1, 2016, meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Public Comment Sue Lynch with the Culture of Risky Drinking Behavior Coalition spoke to offer support for the Social Host ordinance and agreed the language of the ordinance was written well.

Present Monthly Claims The Committee reviewed all claims for payment.

Present Monthly Activity The Committee reviewed monthly activity.

Municipal Court Update No meeting was held.

Action and Recommendation to approve Ordinance 5—2016-Ch.103 – Social Hosting

Collins advised the Committee the social host ordinance was created by using several other agency social host ordinance to create one that best suited Holmen. Collins advised he worked with Administrator Heinig and Attorney Weber. Committee asked if the fine was the same with the agencies in the county. Collins advised in working on the ordinance with Attorney Weber it was agreed to lower our minimum fine from \$1000 to \$500 and to keep the maximum fine at \$5000. Lowering the minimum fine would give more discretion for the officer and Attorney Weber. Chuck Olson and Bill Ebner motioned to approve and recommend to board contingent upon the outcome of the public hearing.

Adjourn Chuck Olson and Bill Ebner motioned to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously.
