7. Discussion on supervisor training for Lt. Collins. Executive Development Institute at Fox Valley Technical College (Appleton) is holding an 8 week course. Training is one week at a time from March 2011 through Feb. 2012. Tuition is \$3400 payable in two installments. Upon completion, the course gives 10 credits towards a Masters Degree, which Lt. Collins is working on. Training budget for 2011 is \$5000. If approved, HPD would request to pay \$1200 this year, and the balance in 2012 when the additional amount could be added to the training budget. Training topics and agenda attached.

The additional pistols are needed to equip the new officers and to have a spare pistol in case any are in need of repair. \$1000 was budgeted for the new officer pistols this year. All pistols would have been budgeted for replacement within the next two years as the 10 year life span will be up. For April agenda and action.
