2019 Monthly Municipal Permit

2019 Dog Licenses - No Cat Licensing

All dogs in the Village of Holmen must be vaccinated against rabies and must be licensed by 5 months of age.


A dog license can be purchased between January 1st and April 1st to avoid a late fee and citation. Proof of current rabies vaccination is required to license your dog.

The fee to license your dog is \$12 for an altered dog and \$23 for an unaltered dog.

If you fail to license your dog by April 1st, you must purchase a dog license from the County Clerk's office and pay a late fee of \$25 plus the cost of the dog license. This also applies if you get a new dog and fail to license it within 30 days, your puppy turns 5 months old and you fail to license it, or if you move into the Village with a dog and fail to license it within 30 days. **Limit of 3 dogs/3 cats, with a combination of no more than 4 animals per household.**

Utility Bills

The State of Wisconsin Legislature adopted Act 419 in their 1996 session. The Act prohibits municipalities from attaching delinquent utilities as a lien on the park owners' real property, when the mobile home units are metered individually. To assure collection of utility bills, the Village has established procedures to disconnect customers' water service who do not pay their delinquent bill within a reasonable time. In order to avoid having your water disconnected and a reconnection fee added, please make sure your utility bill is current.

Useful Information

Compost Site: Hours for 2019 - Mondays and Wednesdays, 2:00 pm - 6:00 pm and Saturdays, 8:00 am - 4:00 pm.

Brush Chipping: Brush will be chipped at curbside commencing the first Monday of every month. **Branches Only.**

Sidewalk Snow & Ice Removal: No more than 48 hours after the storm, or you may be fined. Clear mailboxes of snow. Keep fire hydrants cleared of snow for your safety.

Alternate Side Parking: In effect November 1 thru April 1.

Burning is strictly prohibited in the Village of Holmen.

Refuse/Specific Large Items/Recycling	\$39.00/quarter
Sewer	\$15.50/quarter plus \$6.60/1000 gallons
Stormwater	\$12.00/quarter runoff unit charge
Water (3/4" meter rate)	\$18.00/quarter plus \$2.25/1000 gallons
Public Fire Protection (3/4" meter rate)	\$14.10/quarter

Customer classifications other than 1-2 family residential, see back of utility bill for current rates.

Utility payments can be made at the Village Office 8:00 am - 4:30 pm weekdays. The Drop-off Box (outside front of bldg.) is available for payments 24/7. GovPayNow.com or 1-888-604-7888 is available for credit card payments 24/7. Pay location code for **Utilities is "5993"**.

Residential customer's sewer bill is adjusted during summer months for water used for irrigation. For details on this program, contact the Village Utility Department.

The Village of Holmen will continue DNR mandated Cross Connection Inspections. If you are contacted by our contractor, please schedule an appointment with them.
