

VOLLEYBALL RULES 2014

*A match consists of 3 games to 21 points, win by 2, and all 3 games will be played during the match regardless of the outcome of the first 2 games. (Rally Scoring) If time is short, the 3rd game may be played to only 15 points.

*Each team has a designated rotation where a new server comes off the bench each time the serve is won by their team. Front line right player goes to the bench.

*A player may only serve 5 consecutive points in any 1 game. After the 5 serves the team will rotate and maintain the serve with a new server coming off the bench.

*All overhand serving must be done behind the back service line. (**We will call foot faults if the player steps on or over the line**)

*Underhand serving shall start 20' from the net behind a line designated on each court by a painted line or tape. Note: players may move forward of the line as needed to get the ball over the net. But, if the server who crosses the line to serve hits it to the opponents back row it will result in a side-out for their team.

Note: Try to get as many servers as you can to stay behind the service line during the serve with-out stepping on or over the line.

*Serves can be received with a bump or a legal set. **No Spikes!**

*One time out per game per team.

*Note: Members of the team will stay in a rotation designated by their coach for the duration of the match. Teams will start in the same spot that they ended for the 2nd and 3rd games of each match. The team that starts with the serve for games 2 and 3 need to rotate 1 spot before the first serve to start the match to ensure there is a new server for their game.

*Net height of 7' 0". Use net antenna's if you have them available.
