The grand opening will start at 9 am followed by a demonstration of the game at 9:15 am. Instruction will be provided on how to play the game during the demonstration as well as group instruction after the game as you give it a go yourself!

Pickleball, the fastest growing sport in America, is a paddle sport for all ages and all athletic ability levels. It combines many elements of tennis, badminton and ping-pong and adds its own rules as well. It is played both indoors or outdoors on a badminton-sized court with a net lower than a tennis net. Players use a paddle and a plastic ball with holes to win a game to 11 points. Pickleball can be played as doubles or singles, but 95% of all game play is as doubles.

It has very **simple rules** and is **easy to learn and play**. **Teenagers love the fun** of it in schools and many are flooding into Pickleball tournaments. **Seniors love the social aspects** and the **ability to stay active and fit**. **Tennis, racquetball, squash and ping pong players love the competitive nature of it.**

Learn to Play Pickleball! Classes

USAPA Pickleball Ambassador Jan Lucas along with other experienced Pickleball players will teach you the basics of the game: fundamental strokes, serving, rules of play and terminology. This will get you ready to attend any of the open play/drop in sessions wherever pickleball is played.

Pre-registration is required for the one two-hour session and a minimum of 3 people, a maximum of 12 people. Paddles and balls will be provided. Please bring water to drink and appropriate tennis court shoes.

Choose from one of the following dates:

Class #1: Monday, July 22, 6-8 pm

Class #2: Saturday, July 27, 10 am - 12 noon

Class #3: Sunday, August 11, 4-6 pm.



Note: If there is a weather issue (too windy, rainy, or way too hot) note that participants can join the next clinic, and if not workable, the instructor is willing to find another time.
