McHugh advised Committee of a Wi-Grants IntelliGrants opportunity. Holmen PD has requested under the grant three complete mobile data computers (includes all related components and licenses). The request would replace an existing computer that is out of service due to age and provide two new additional squad computers. Two new computers would have been requested in the 2013 budget to replace aging computers as was already done beginning in 2012.

Total budget is \$25064.72. The grant is stating there is a 25% local match. Chief McHugh will be checking further on how the local match needs to be paid. Grant application deadline is 8-3-12. Grant can be turned down if the Board decides the local match is not a budgeted expense.

Motion Horvath, 2<sup>nd</sup> Kulcinski to recommend the apply for the grant. Carried unan.

McHugh advised Committee that another grant has been awarded to the Holmen PD in the amount of \$2500. This is a non-matching local fund grant for security systems. Holmen PD intends to purchase portable security camera systems to use for crime prevention and apprehension.

McHugh also advised Committee that Holmen PD had participated in the Click It or Ticket Program. Holmen PD was one of about 50 agencies in the state that were selected at large to win a \$4000 traffic safety grant. The \$4000 can be spent by Holmen PD on anything traffic safety related (light bars, sirens, radars, spike strips, etc). The Police Dept will begin compiling a list of items to be purchased from this \$4000 award.
