Village of Holmen Law Enforcement Committee March 3, 2020

The meeting of the Holmen Law Enforcement Committee was held Tuesday March 3, 2020, in the Village Hall board room.

Chair Dawn Kulcinski called the meeting to order at 6:00pm.

Present at the meeting: Committee members Dawn Kulcinski, Doug Jorstad, and Rodney Stanek. Also in attendance were Administrator Scott Heinig and Chief Shane Collins.

Approval of Minutes Doug Jorstad and Rodney Stanek motioned to approve the minutes of the December 3, 2019, meeting. The motion carried unanimously.

Discussion/Possible Action Recommendation on Purchase of Watchguard Camera

Collins advised this is a budgeted item and this camera will be put in the new patrol car. Collins advised this is the same cameras they have been using which also includes a five year warranty, Collins advised this does not include a body camera because the Department has eight right now and still have two year warranty left on the eight. Collins advised the price for the camera is \$6845.00. Committee unanimously motioned to recommend to the Board for the approval of purchasing a Watchguard camera of one Watchguard camera for the price of \$6845.00.

Possible Action and Recommendation on Purchase of Stalker Radar

Collins advised this is a budgeted item and the Stalker radar will also be placed in the new patrol car. Collins advised the price for the Stalker radar is \$3071.00. Committee unanimously motioned to recommend to the Board for the approval of purchasing a Stalker Radar for the price of \$3071.00.

Possible Action to purchase Motorola Radio Collins advised this radio will be placed in the new patrol car and is a budgeted item. Collins advised the Motorola radio would be purchased from Baycom for the price of \$1021.54. Committee unanimously approved the purchase of the Motorola radio for \$1021.54.

Additional Items Collins advised the department and Village President had received some complaints of fast traffic on Long Coulee Road. Collins advised the Officers had been continuing sitting in this area when time permits. Collins advised last week Officer sat in this area even more and found one traffic violation. Collins advised he sat in the area in his personal truck with a laser radar and found no traffic violations.

Collins advised the Holmen Rotary has donated \$6000.00 towards the new K9 Officer.

Adjourn Doug Jorstad and Rodney Stanek motioned to adjourn. The motion carried unanimously. Meeting ended 6:25pm.
