

**Village of Holmen  
Special Board Meeting  
Holmen Village Hall – Board Room  
Tuesday, April 26, 2011  
7:00 pm**

President Proctor called the Holmen Village Special Board meeting to order at 7:00 p.m. on April 26, 2011 at the Holmen Village Hall.

Public Comment was opened. People spoke equally in favor and in opposition of fluoridation. Many spoke to the 2008 binding referendum results. Comments closed at 7:44 pm.

Ryan Olson/Nancy Proctor motioned to reduce the Village's level of fluoride to the State of Wisconsin; Department of Health Services new recommended amount of 0.7 milligrams of fluoride per liter of water provided a variance granted by Wisconsin DNR. Motion failed with Olson and Proctor in favor, Dunham, Horvath, Moser and Kulcinski opposed.

Dunham motioned to temporarily suspend the fluoridation of Holmen's water supply pending further clarification of recommended quantity amounts put forth by the U.S. Department of Health and Human Services, effective immediately. Proctor requested that a time frame be determined; one was not agreed upon. Motion carried with Dunham, Horvath, Moser and Kulcinski in favor, Olson and Proctor opposed.

Ryan Olson/Mike Dunham motioned to adjourn. Motion carried unanimously. The meeting adjourned at 8:27 p.m.
